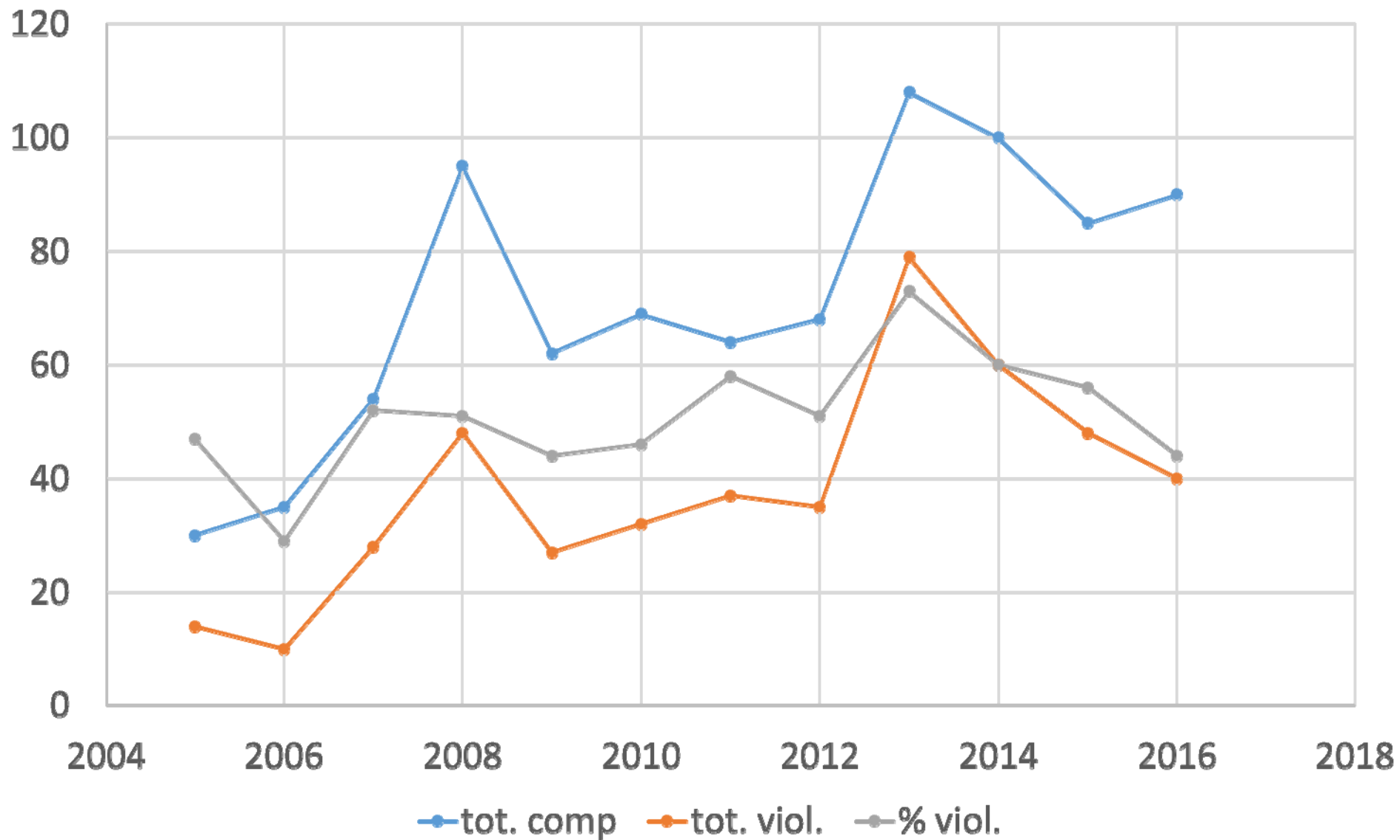

## Drift Data Tabulation Parameters

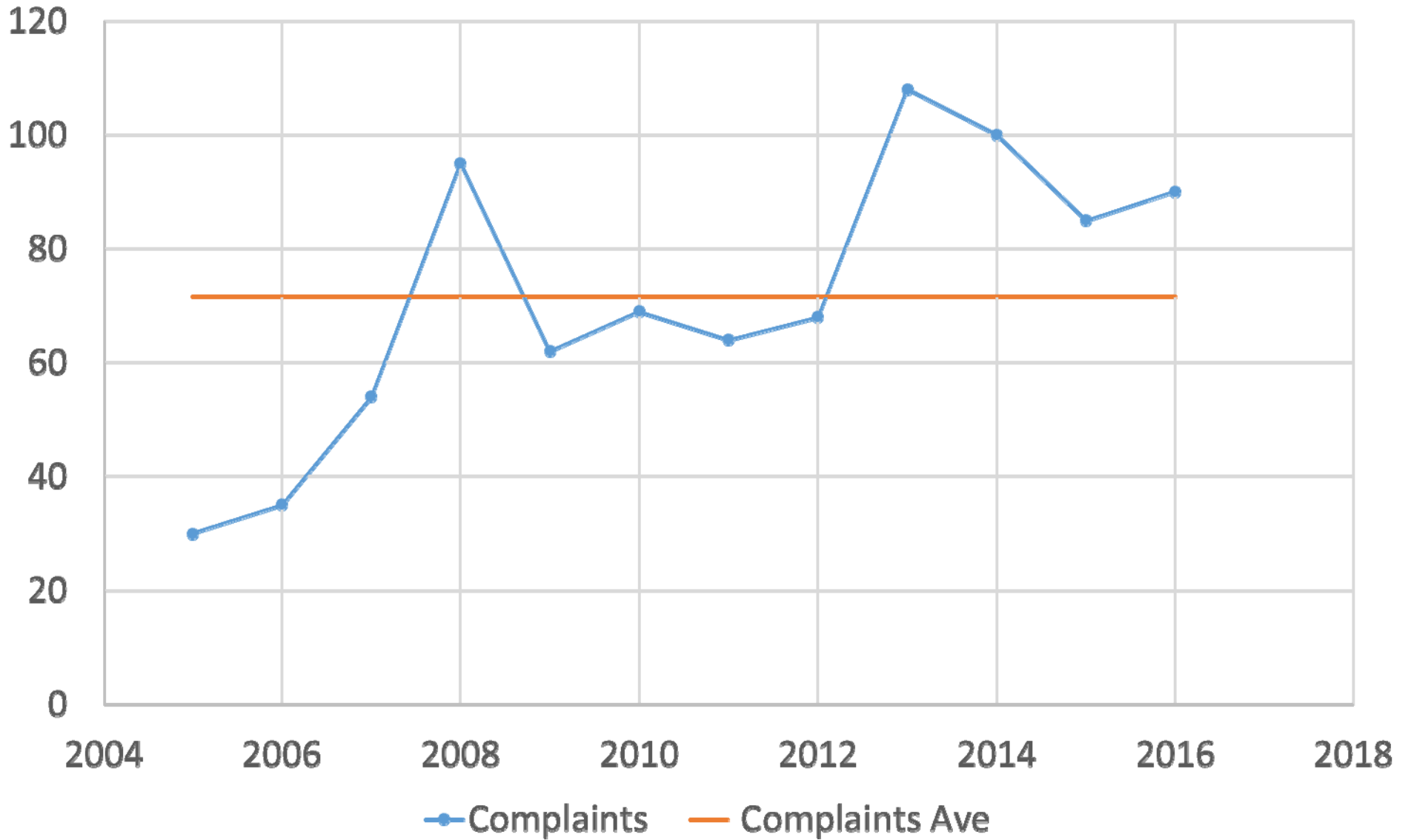
- Applicator type or category:
  - Homeowner, general public, neighbor
  - Farmer, grower, private applicator
  - Category 1...commercial agriculture
  - Category 3...lawn, ornamental, golf course
  - Category 6...industrial vegetation management, ROW
  - Category 8...mosquito control
  - Category 11...aerial application
  - Other
- Violations documented thru complaint investigation

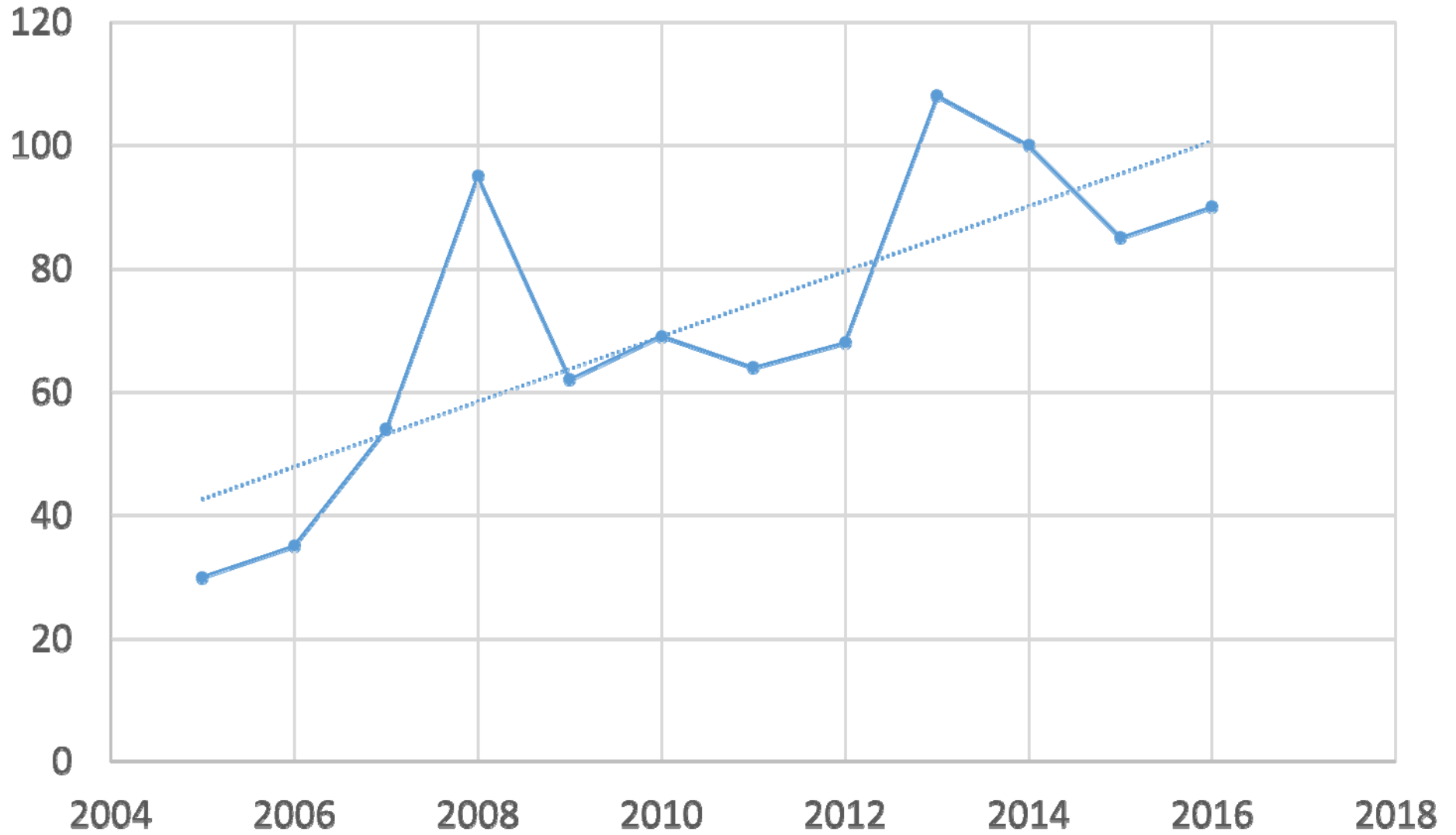
## Total Drift Complaints, Violations, & % Violations



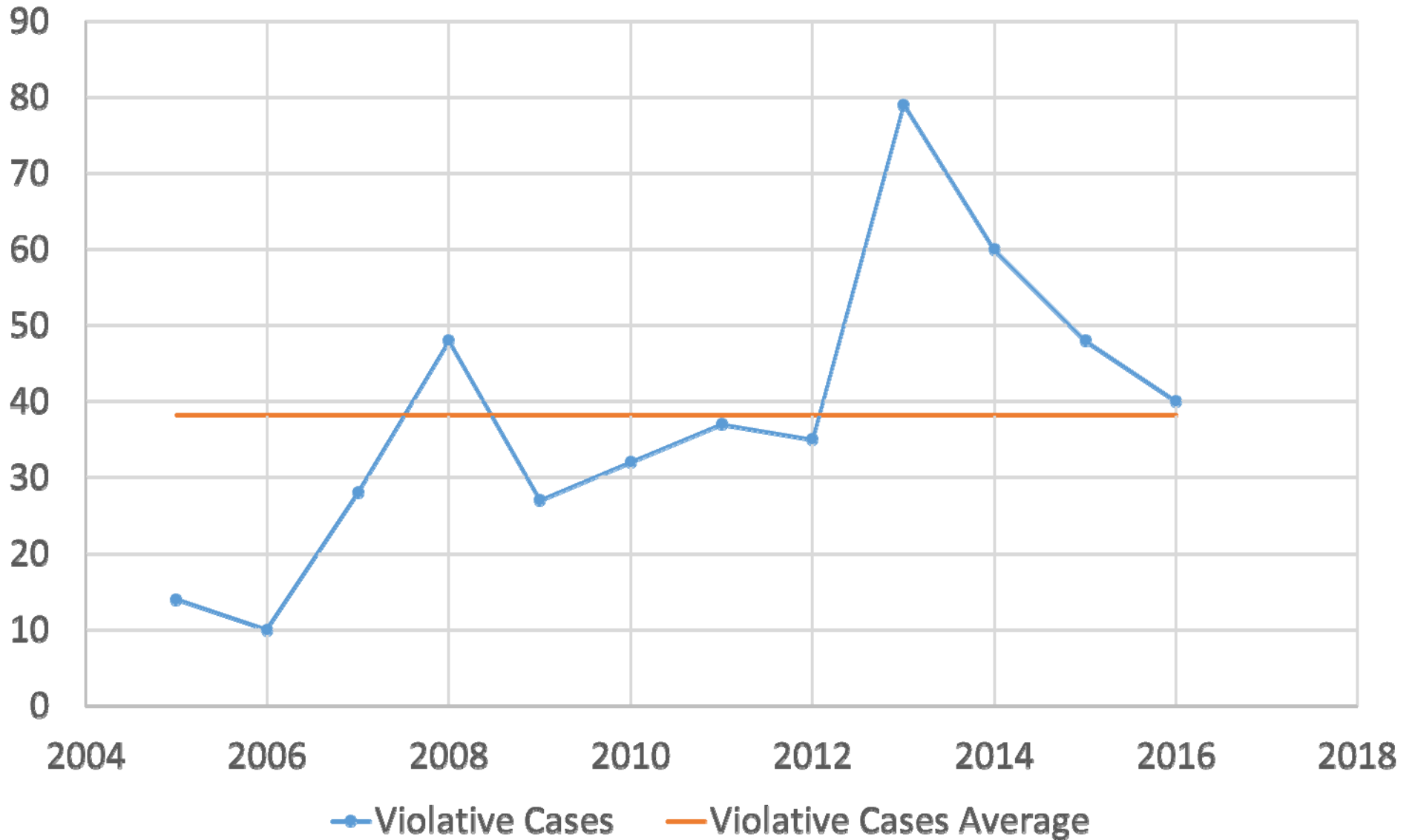
# 2005-2016 Total Annual Drift Complaints (average)



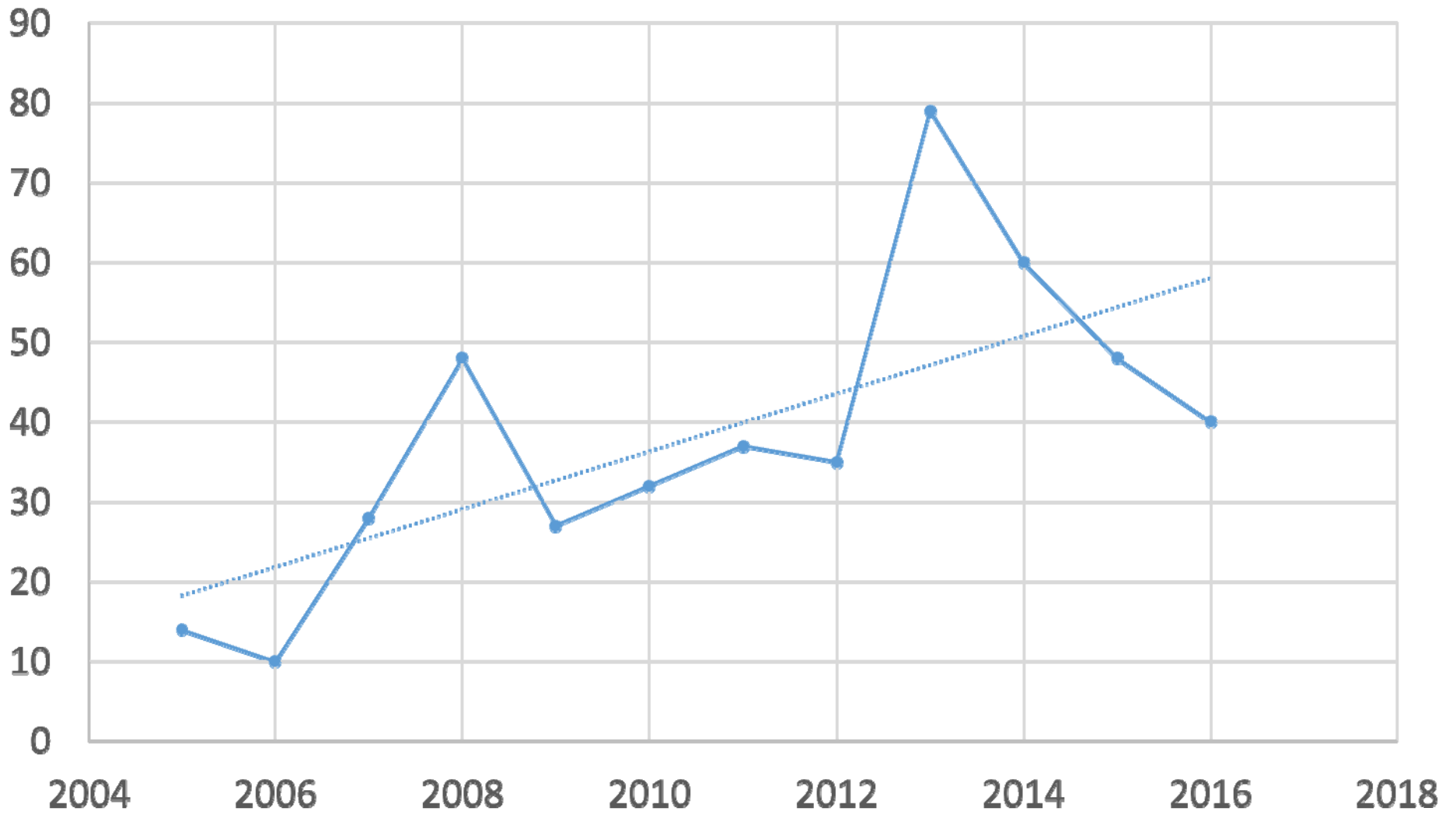
# 2005-2016 Total Annual Drift Complaints (trend)



# 2005-2016 Total Annual Drift Violations (average)

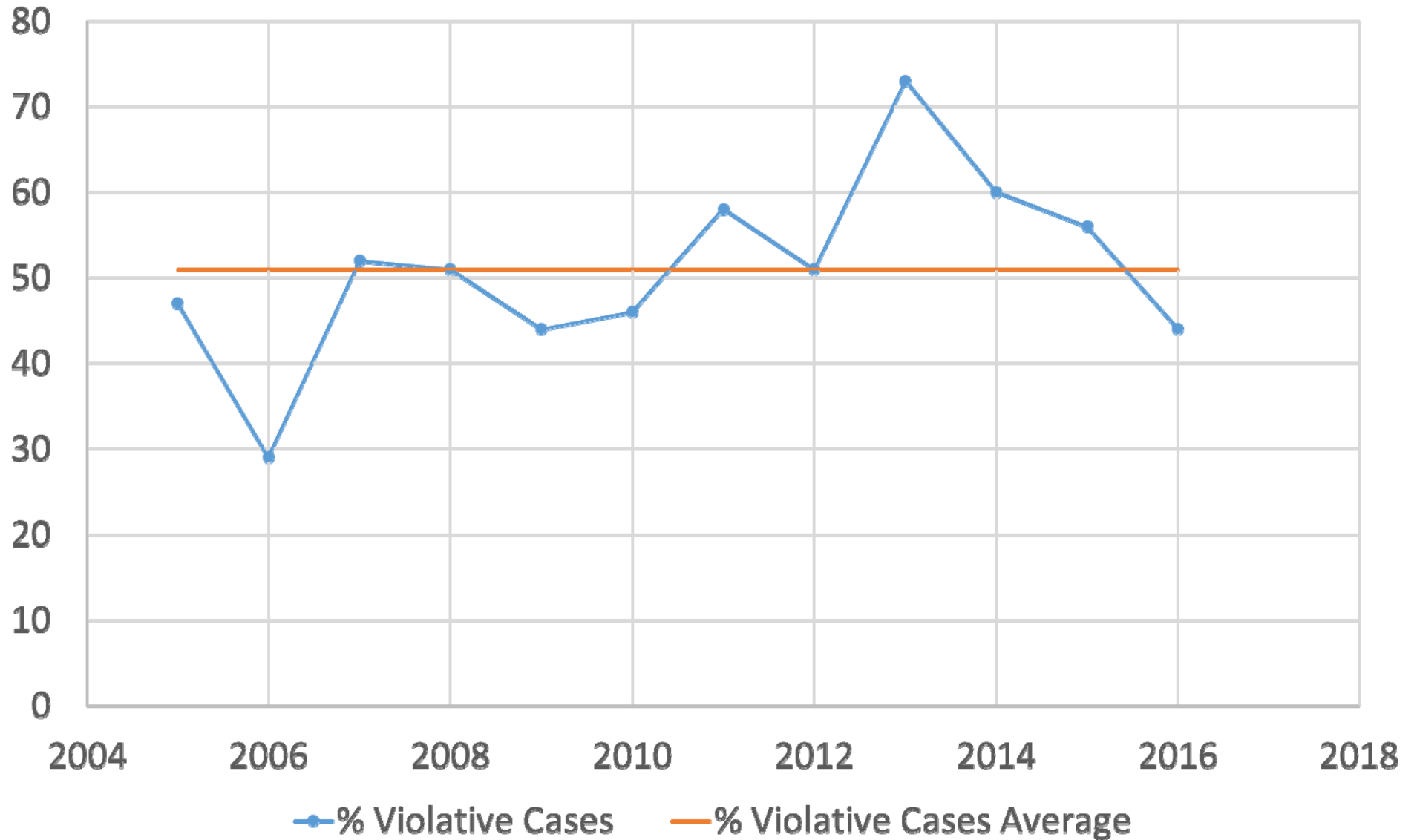


# 2005-2016 Total Annual Drift Violations (trend)



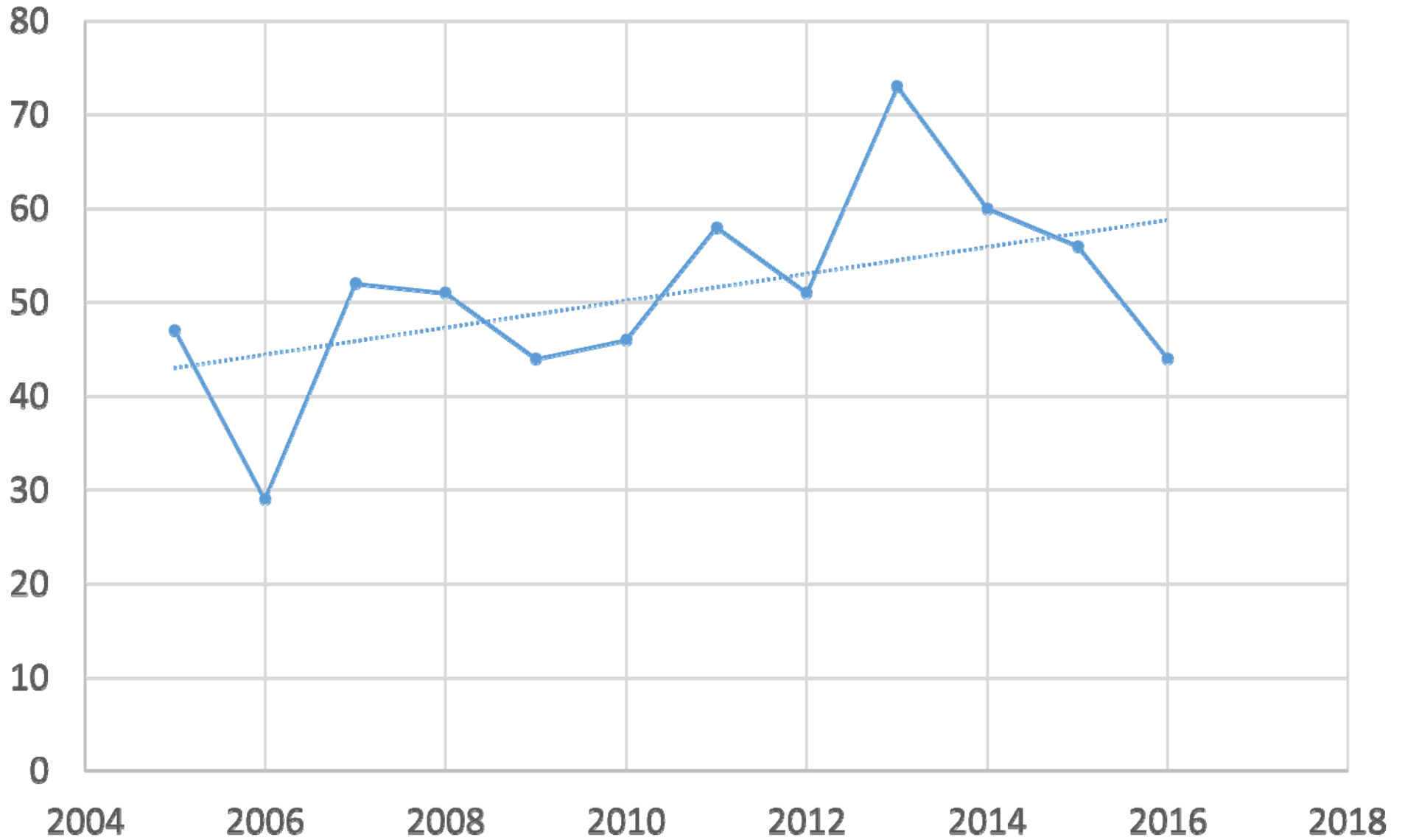

## Total % Annual Violative Drift Cases (average)

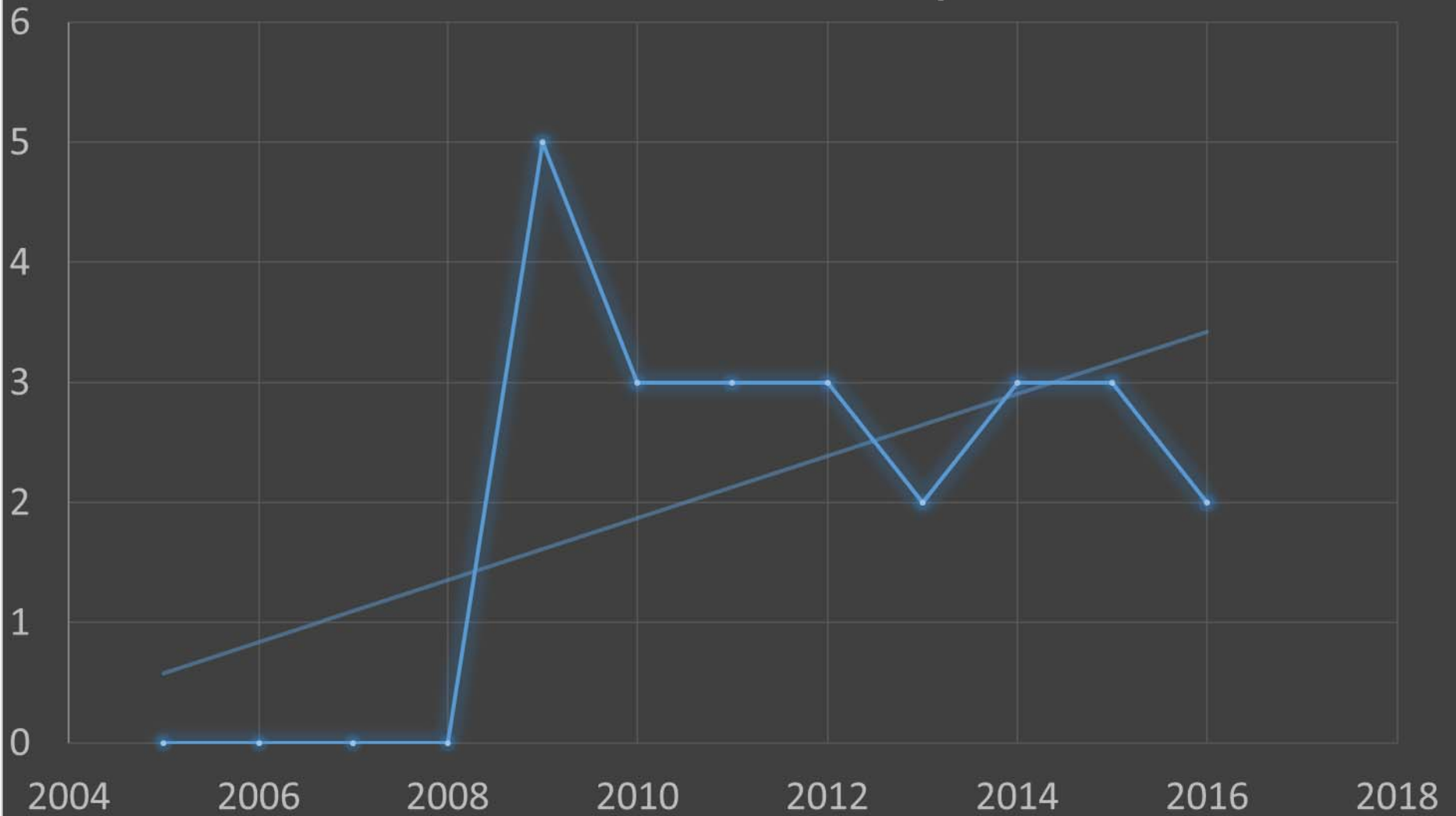




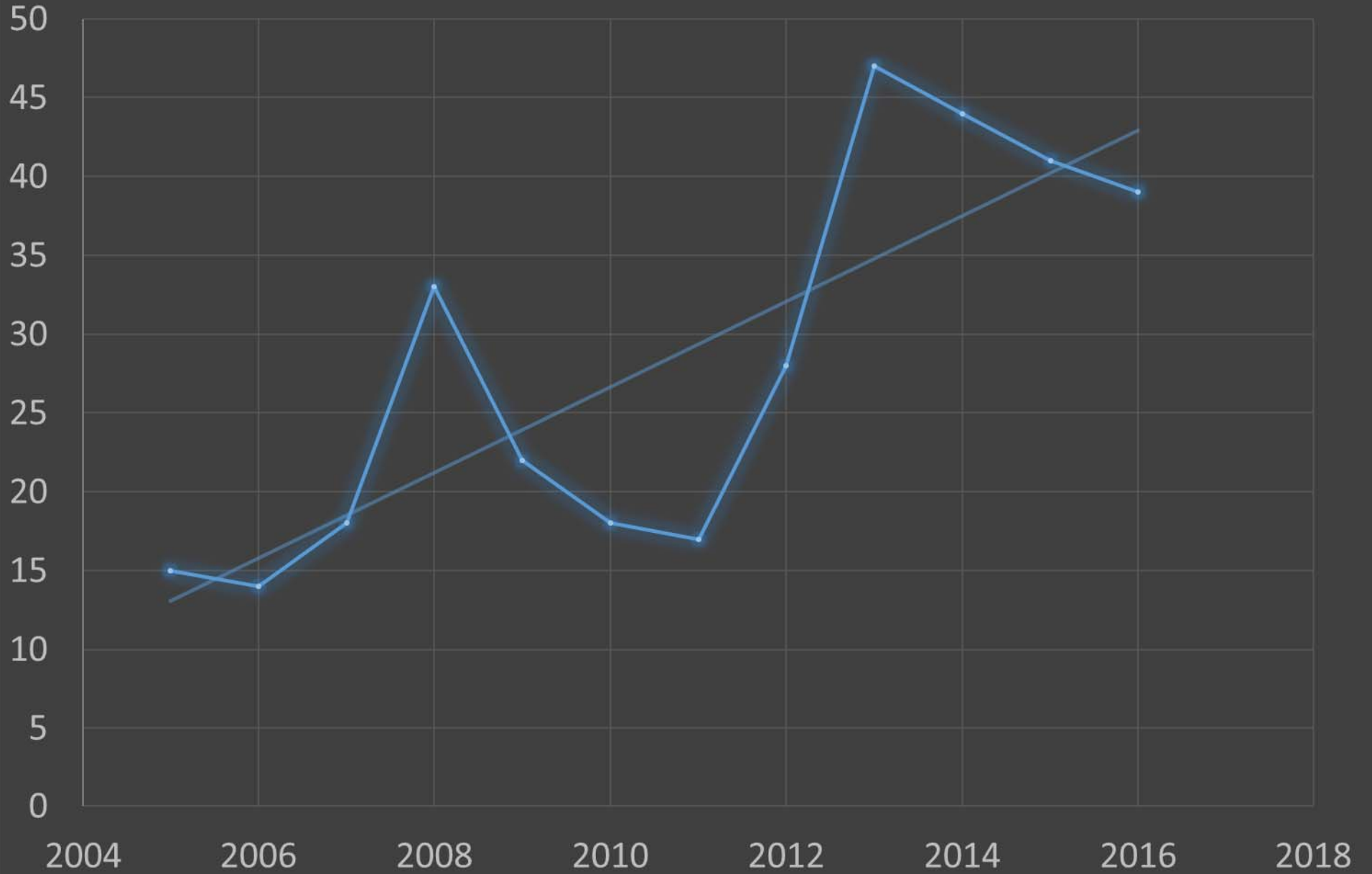

(trend)



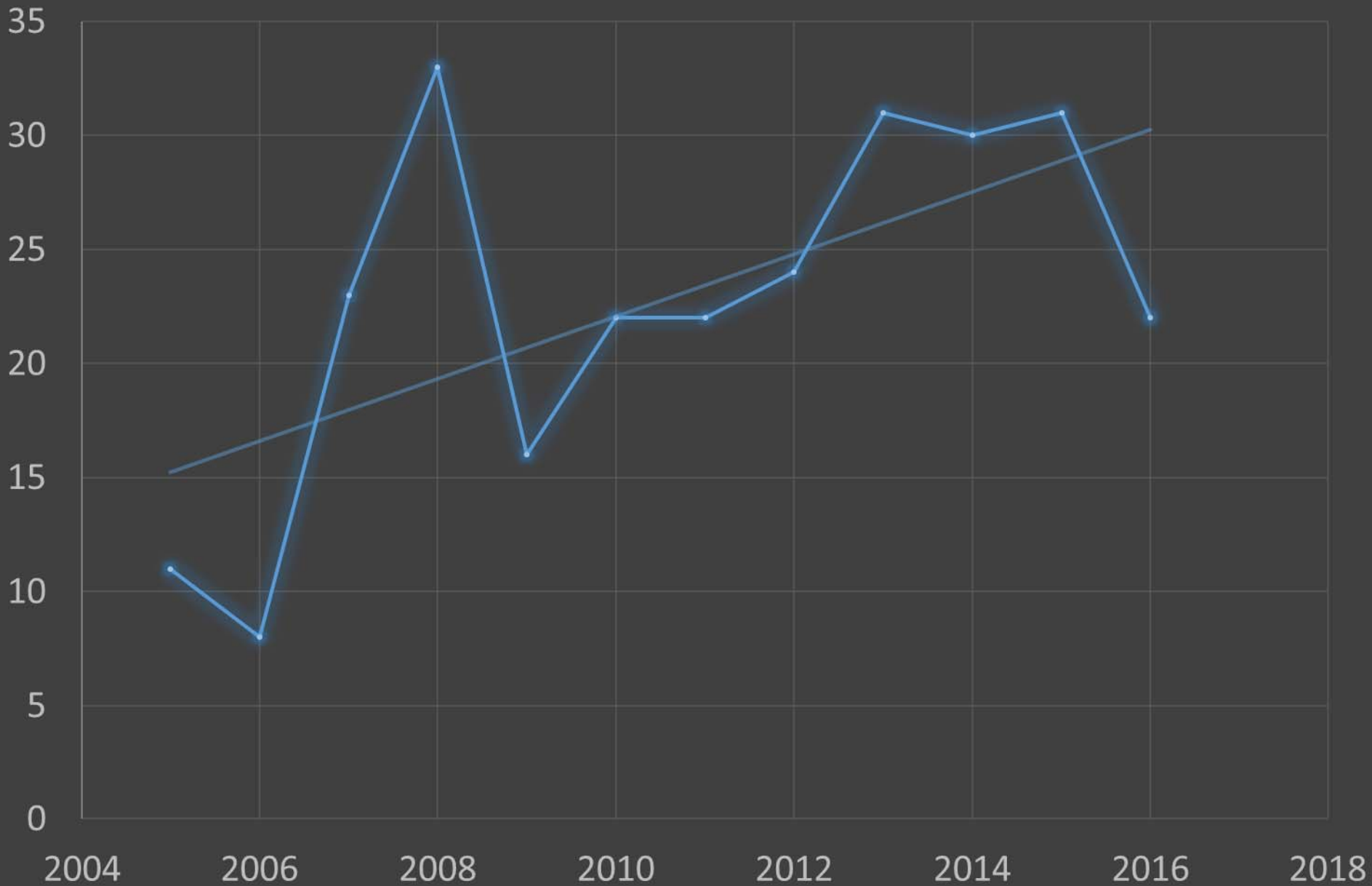

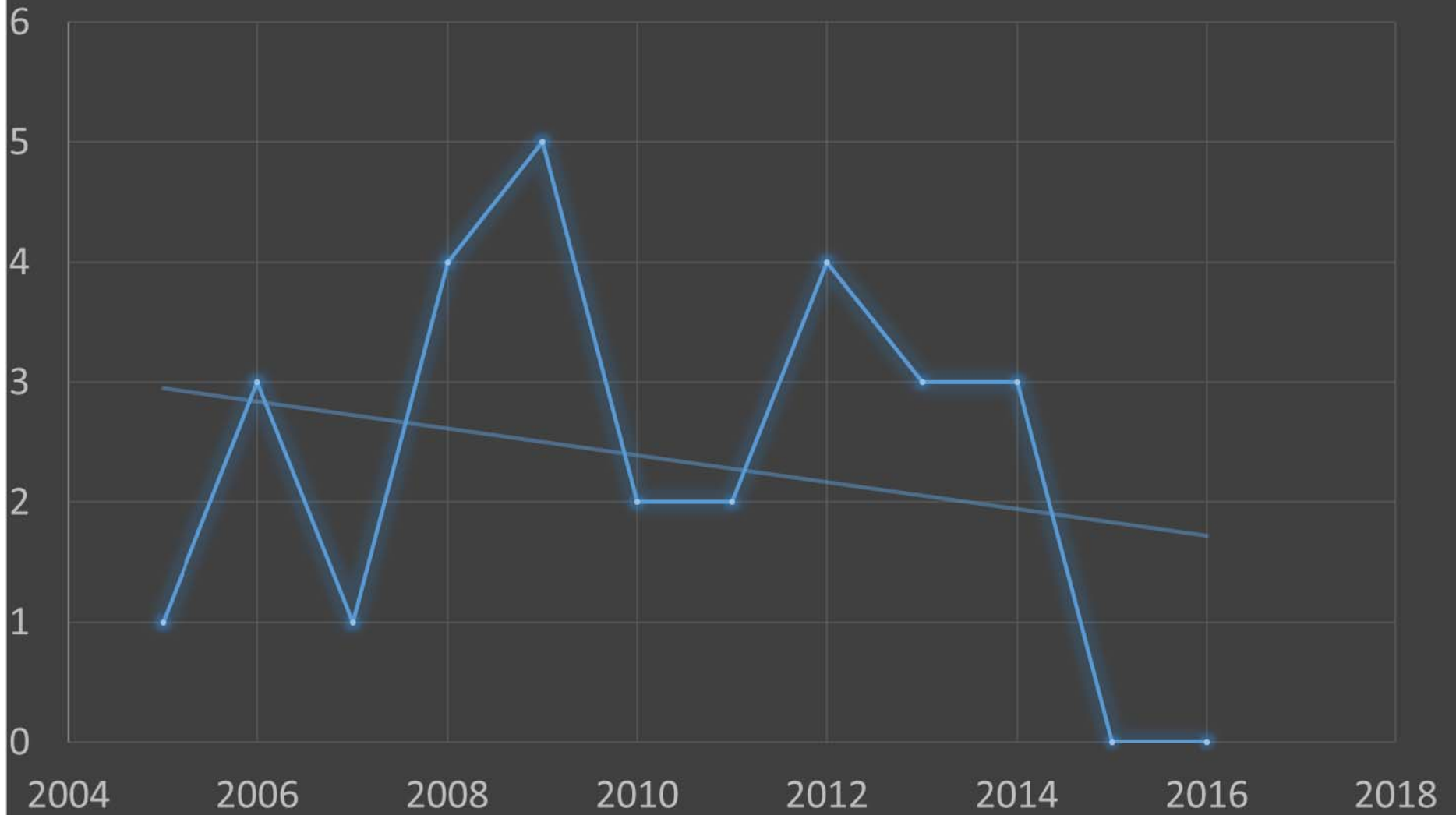

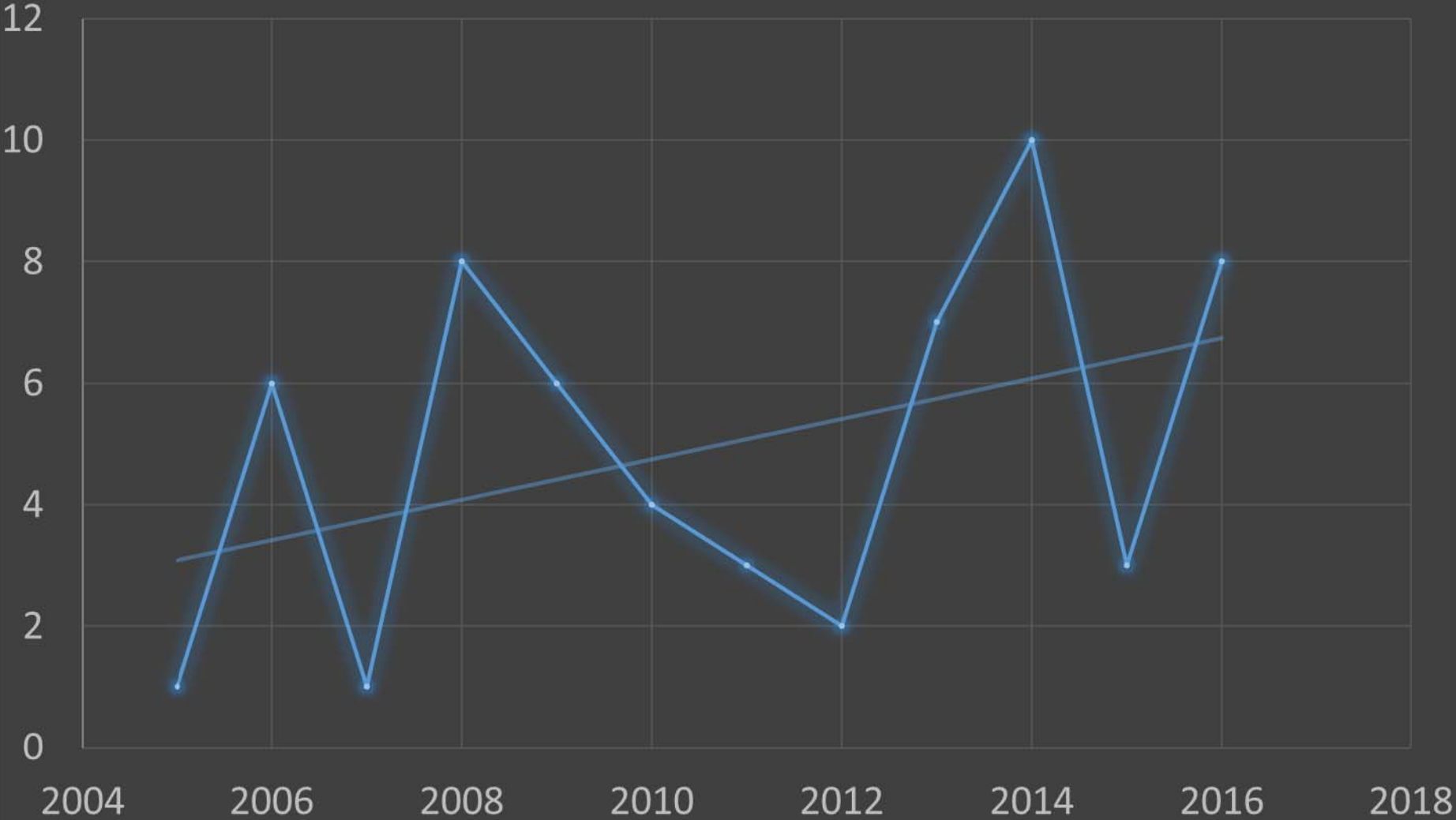

## Turf Applicator Drift Complaints



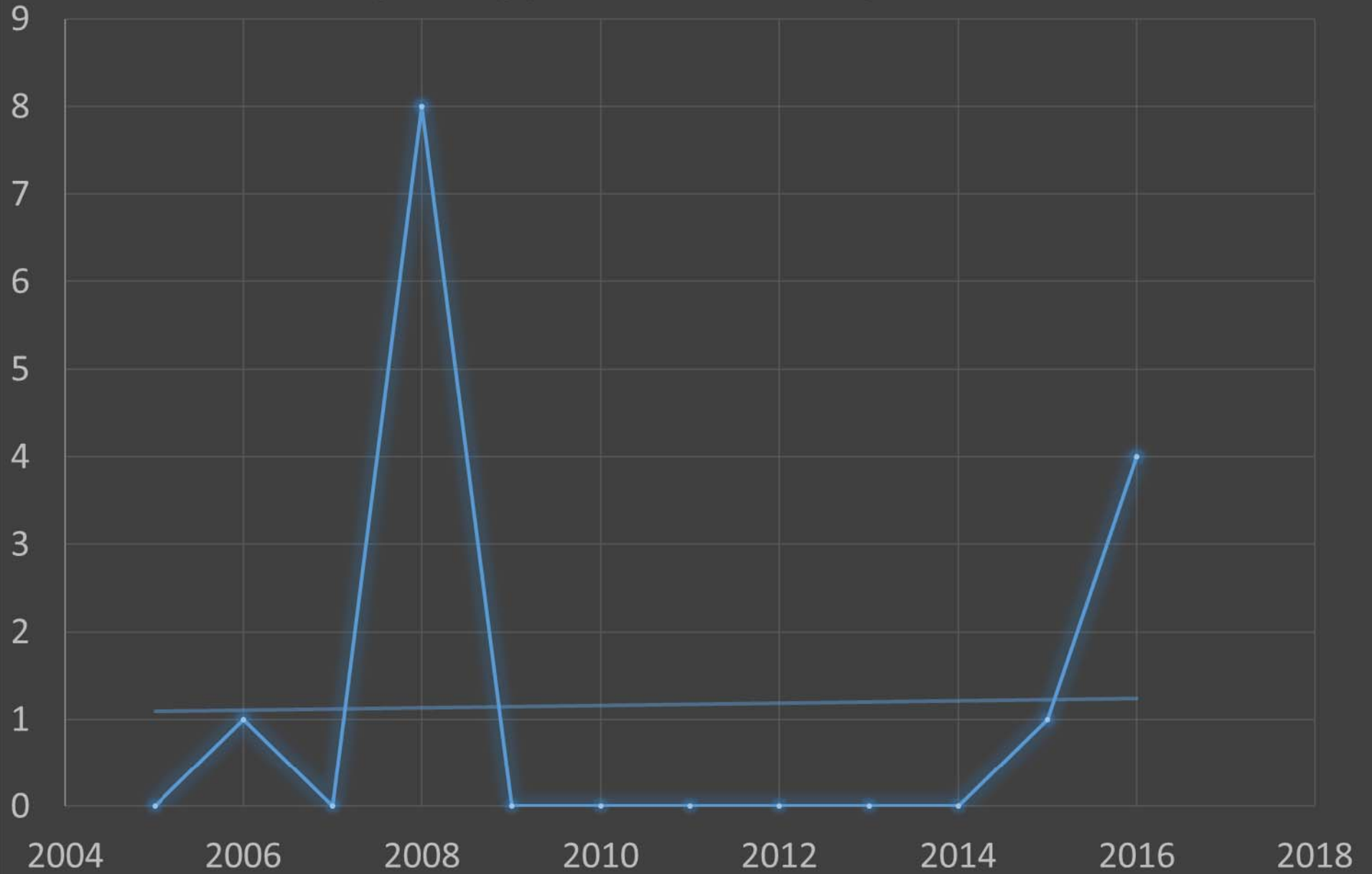

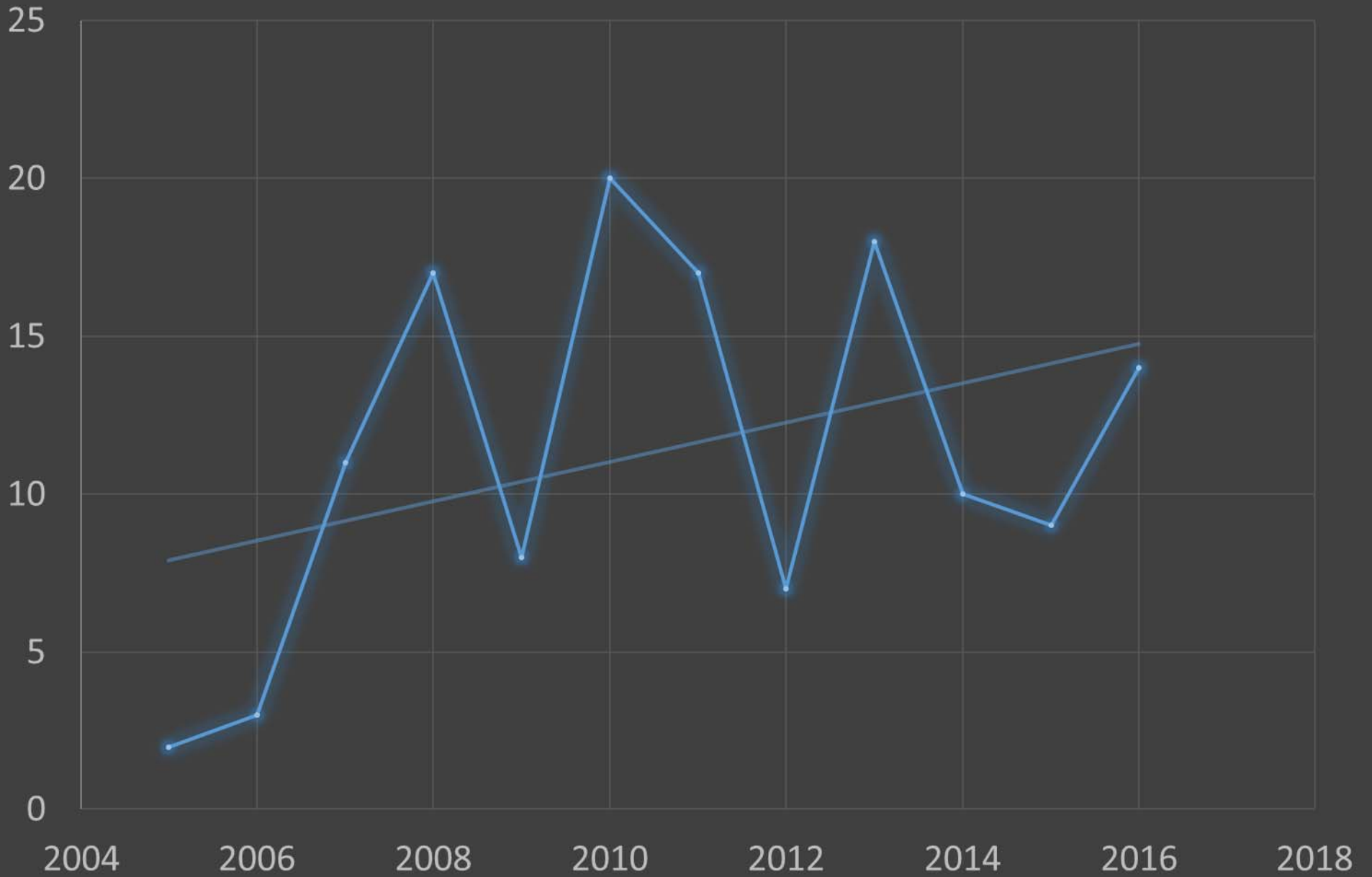
