

FY 2021 Mosquito Control Complaints to OISC

Cases that specifically mention mosquito control and category 7a:

PS21-0094...Complainant stated she is concerned that a mosquito application made to a neighbor's lawn drifted onto her property.

PS21-0200...Complainant stated that monthly mosquito control applications made to his neighbor's property routinely drift onto his property.

PS21-0220...Complainant stated Company A made a mosquito control application on July 7, 2021. The following day after a substantial rain the koi in their fishpond were found dead

PS21-0239...Complainant stated she observed a Company B mosquito control application drift onto bird baths and her dog. The application was made to her neighbor's property on July 12, 2021 about 1 pm.

PS21-0305...Anonymous complainant stated Company C is applying Talstar at 10 to 17 day intervals in violation of the label which says 30 day intervals

PS21-0306...Company D was determined to be unlicensed.

Cases that specifically mention mosquito control and category 8:

PS21-0177...Complainant stated neighbor had a mosquito control application that drifted onto his property chasing him inside

PS21-0209...Complainant stated repeated mosquito control applications by the City of X killed his dog

PS21-0285...Complainant stated he observed the City Y Sanitary District making a mosquito application at 4:30 pm thereby endangering pollinators.

PS21-0335...When conducting online search for routine business inspection, I discovered a business called "mosquito control" at the same location for "Lawn Care E". The second mosquito business does not appear to be licensed at this time.
