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Commercial Applicator Restricted Use Pesticide Application Record Requirements

- (1) Name and address of customer or property owner of the site of application.
- (2) Address, geographic coordinates, or general location description of site of application, if different from subsection (1).
- (3) Name and license number of the commercial applicator.
- (4) Date of application (month, day, and year).
- (5) Start and stop times of the application.
- (6) Description of plant, crop, animal, commodity, stored product, or site treated.
- (7) Principal pests to be controlled.
- (8) Specific acreage, area, parts of a structure, parts of a property, or number of plants or animals treated, or other appropriate description.
- (9) Brand name of pesticide product applied.
- (10) EPA registration number of the pesticide product applied, if applicable.
- (11) Amount of pesticide product used, expressed as either total quantity or volume of:
 - (A) packaged product; or
 - (B) diluted mixture and active ingredient concentration (percentage).

Records must be kept for 2 years. Records can be kept electronically; no specific form is required.

***Restricted Use Pesticides can ONLY be applied by a fully certified applicator.**
