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Private Applicator (Farmer) Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP) Application Record Requirements

1. Address, geographic coordinates, or general location description of site of application.
2. Name and license number of the certified applicator.
3. Date of application (month, day, year).
4. Start and stop times of the application.
5. Description of plant, crop or site treated.
6. Principal pests to be controlled.
7. Specific acreage, area, parts of a property or number of plants or animals treated, or other appropriate description.
8. Brand name of pesticide product applied.
9. EPA registration number of the pesticide product applied.
10. Amount of pesticide product used, expressed as either total quantity or volume of:
 - A) Packaged product; or
 - B) Diluted mixture and active ingredient concentration (percentage).

Records must be kept for 2 years. Records can be kept electronically; no specific form is required. Indiana registered RUPs available at https://oisc.purdue.edu/pesticide/pdf/rup_listing.pdf

Restricted Use Pesticides can ONLY be applied by a certified applicator or a noncertified applicator working under the direct supervision of a certified applicator.
