Reciprocity (Revised 07/30/19)

OISC has a reciprocal pesticide applicator certification agreement with the following states in the following certification & licensing categories. What this means is that Indiana will accept out of state certification exams passed by out of state applicators and that the other states will accept Indiana exams passed by Indiana applicators.

It is important to note that even though you may not be required to re-examine to get an out of state license in one of these states, you still **must** apply for their license, show proof of insurance, and pay all of their applicable licensing fees. You should contact the specific state officials for details about their licensing process. Contact information for those states can be found by going to: http://aapco.org/officials.html.

It is also important to note that not every category in each state matches up exactly with every Indiana category. Some categories will be combined or separated differently from state to state.
