



### Category PA (Private Applicator) or Farmer Site Assessment Fact Sheet

This fact sheet can serve as written instructions to a registered technician covering a variety of site-specific precautions to prevent injury to persons or the environment or damage to property. The certified pesticide applicator supervising the registered technician is responsible for determining the need for additional site-specific precautions. This fact sheet **must** be in the possession of the registered technician at the work site and **must** be reviewed by the registered technician prior to each pesticide application.

- I have a label for each pesticide product to be used at the job site.
- I will be wearing the personal protective equipment (safety gear) required by the label.
- My certified supervisor's name is \_\_\_\_\_, and I am able to contact him/her by \_\_\_\_\_.
- I am at the correct application site/field.
- I have verified that this site has the correct target crop at the labeled growth stage.
- I have the proper pesticide(s) loaded for this application site.
- I will be applying the pesticide within 30 miles of my supervising Private Applicator.
- My application equipment was cleaned out prior to switching to this pesticide.
- My application equipment is calibrated and in proper working order.
- The current wind speed and direction do not favor off-target drift.
- I have checked the application site for any of the following:
  - Known sensitive/concerned neighbors
  - Unprotected workers or other persons
  - Off-target vegetation such as sensitive crops, gardens or ornamentals
  - Potential for runoff (slope, highly erodible land, approaching thunderstorms)
  - Lakes or ponds (within 200 ft. of application)
  - Streams, intermittent streams or rivers (within 66 ft. of application)
  - Water wells, abandoned wells, drainage wells or sink holes (within 50 ft. of application)
